## Teachers Feedback Analysis 2022 - 2023

We received feedback from 29 teachers on their respective subject syllabus. The feedback forms have been designed with the help of Google forms and shared with the teachers through social media groups. They were asked to submit their responses to a set of twelve statements on a 5-point Likert Scale in which choices range from Strongly Agree (1) to Strongly Disagree (5). The feedback thus received was then analyzed by the Committee and shared with the Principal, IQAC and the faculty for discussion. The analysis of the feedback is given Statement-wise and is as follows:

**Statement 1:** The Depth of the syllabus content is adequate to have substantial learning results – majority of the teachers i.e. 59.3% agreed with the statement while 33.3% teachers strongly agreed and 7.4% teachers were uncertain while 0% teachers disagreed and strongly disagreed.

## **Structured Feedback Received from Students on Design and Review of Syllabus**

### **ANALYSIS OF STUDENTS FEEDBACK REPORT 2022-23**

The feedback is taken from 324 students from Arts, Commerce and Science streams. The feedback forms have been designed with the help of Google forms and shared with the students through social media groups. They were asked to submit their responses to a set of thirteen statements on a 4-point Scale with different choices. The feedback thus received was then analysed by the Committee and shared with the Principal, IQAC and the faculties for discussion. The analysis of the feedback is given Statement-wise as follows:

**Statement 1:** The syllabus of each subject was – majority of the students i.e. 51.54% found the syllabus challenging while 40.74 % found it adequate.

**Statement 2:** Academic ability to understand the course was – majority of students i.e. 53.40% found it more than adequate, 34.57% found it simply adequate while 1.85% agreed that it was inadequate and 10.19% stated as unable to say.

**Statement 3:** The Understanding level of the course was – 21.30% students found it Manageable while 61.73% students found it as convenient, 12.96% students found it difficult while 4.01% stated it as very difficult.

**Statement 4:** How much of the syllabus was covered in the class – majority of the students i.e. 48.77% agreed that 85% to 100% syllabus was covered while 25.31% students said that 70-85% syllabus was covered. 24.07% held the opinion in favour of 55-70% and 11.42% students opted for less than 55%.

**Statement 5:** What is your opinion about the library material for the course – majority of the students i.e. 52.78% opined excellent while 33.02% students found it sufficient. 6.79% students opined insufficient and 5.56% found it poor.

**Statement 6:** How was the availability of material for the prescribed reading - 38.27% students agreed that it was very good while 51.54% students opined good. 6.17% students found it insufficient while 4.01% students declared it poor.

**Statement 7:** How was the role of internal assessment - 34.26% students called it effective while 38.58% held the view that it was moderate. 24.38% students found it helpful while 2.78% students opted for unable to say.

**Statement 8:** What impact, according to you, will the internal assessment have on your course grade – majority of the students i.e. 50.62% agreed that it helps improving while 29.01% students opined that it was unfavourable. 15.12% students found it ineffective while 5.25% students opted for not at all.

**Statement 9:** Were your assignments discussed with you? – majority of the students i.e. 53.70% opted for yes fully while 25.62% students said yes partly, 15.74% students said sometimes while 4.94% students opted for not at all.



**Statement 10:** Was there any scope in syllabus for personal interaction with teachers - 52.47% students said fully yes while 35.49% students opined as some extent. 6.48% students said no while 5.56% students opted for can't say.

**Statement 11:** Did you visit industries, museum, laboratories, science centres, banks and any other colleges and universities? - 34.88% students said yes frequently, while 29.32% students opted for sometimes. 15.74% students said rarely while 20.06% students opted for not at all.

**Statement 12:** Whether the course covered Gender Issues, Human Values, and environmental issues? – Majority of students is i.e. 45.06% opined yes considerably while 43.83% students opted for yes partly. 5.86% students opted for not at all while 5.25% students said can't say.

**Statement 13:** Did the syllabus have the practical value – majority of students i.e. 51.54% opted for yes fully while 17.90% students said yes partly. 24.69% students agreed that it had to some extent while 5.86% students preferred can't say.
